We are taking part in a friendly TTRS competition involving schools in England. The competition runs from 07:30 am on Tuesday 14th November 2023 to 19:30 pm Thursday 16th November 2023. It's all done online via Times Tables Rock Stars: Play (ttrockstars.com). Please check you are using the latest version of this at home or reload the Times Tables Rock Stars app from the app store. Children can play in any gamemode with every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, earning themselves, their class and the school a point. TTRS will calculate the class average. I Winning classes in the school and in the competition as a whole will be the ones with the highest average. To support player wellbeing, there is a daily time limit of 60-minutes per player. Your child can log using their Numbots or TTRS username and password. Teachers will remind children about this competition after half term but in the meantime, let's start practicing now; ready to show England what amazing Times Tables Rockstars we are!
