<u>Vision</u>

Every child at St Katharine's will have the opportunity to flourish in French through the high-quality, sequential teaching of a foreign language which will foster their curiosity about language and deepen their understanding of the world. Children will have the opportunity to express their ideas and thoughts in another language and will understand and respond to its speakers both in speech and in writing.

A French learner will develop four skills. In French, they will be able to: -

Listen

Listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding Explore and appreciate the patterns and sounds of French through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sounds and meaning of French words

Speak

Speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases, clauses and basic language structures Increase their confidence, fluency and spontaneity Improve the accuracy of their pronunciation and intonation by joining in with songs, games and rhymes Engage in conversations by asking questions, expressing opinions, responding to others and presenting their ideas orally to others

Read

Read words, phrases and clauses Broaden their vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new words

Write

Write words, phrases and clauses and adapt these to create new sentences to express ideas clearly



<u>Overview</u>

- French is taught at Key Stage 2 at St Katharine's Primary School (Year 3 to Year 6)
- Children have the opportunity to experience all four French skills (listening, speaking, reading and writing) during the course of each year.
- Some work is recorded in French books.
