

Worship

We have been treated to two fabulous whole school worships from 6JH (Black History Month) and 6TW (World Values Day), both linking to our worship theme of 'Be a Beacon of Light'. We have also been thinking about being a Youth Sport Trust 'Beacon Well School' and how this reflects Matthew 5:14-16, "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others."



The Nourish and Flourish Kitchen Update

As you know, we launched our new school kitchen in June, supported by Educatering. The staff are employed by the school and we manage and run the kitchen on a day to day basis. Educatering consult with us on menus, training and health and safety.

There have been a few teething problems that we have been working on and these have been echoed by feedback from the children this week. The main issue for the children seems to be consistency of pizza portion sizes. We have now changed the pizza option, based on their feedback, so that pizza will always be served with sweetcorn and wedges instead of salad and coleslaw.

The salad bar has a wide range of choices and we do encourage the children to use it and take as much as they want - the pasta is very popular and on a couple of occasions has run out, which it shouldn't, so we are carefully monitoring this. On a typical day, the salad bar will have most of the following: cucumber, peppers, pasta, lettuce, tomatoes, sweetcorn, carrot, potato salad, couscous. Our survey shows a real variety across different classes in their preferred items so we will maintain a range so that there will always be something that they like.

The team will take a closer look at the survey: the children shared their highlights, criticisms, suggestions and have given useful feedback (aside from asking for sushi and steak!). Tweaks will be made where possible and most importantly we will continue to focus on the portion sizes and encouraging topping up from the salad bar for all children.
