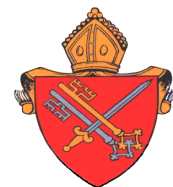

### Year 6 Gamechangers

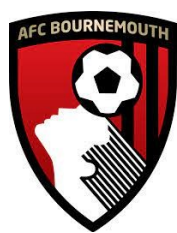

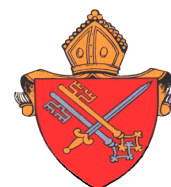
