Pupil Premium Funding

In receipt of benefits?

- You can register for free school meals and the school will get an additional £1385 a year. This is part of what is known as 'Pupil Premium Funding'.
- Please do register, even if your child is currently getting a free infant school meal (EY-yr2) or prefers to eat a packed lunch.
- We use our pupil premium funding to support teaching and learning, our curriculum, wellbeing and mental health and wider curriculum opportunities. Your child will be entitled to free school meals throughout their time here.


Parking
