# Worship

Our 'Gamechangers' theme has continued with a focus on a medical technology company called Zipline that sends medical supplies by drone to villages in Rwanda - the children watched some exciting videos of the drones being launched, during Mrs St John's visit last year. Some of our Global Neighbours ambassadors told the school about how they have taken action against food waste in our school by weighing the food thrown away each day, collecting pupil voice and starting a campaign. The Grylls House Team led a super worship about Bear Grylls as a gamechanger, linking to our SEASIDE theme environment. Whole school worship this week was thinking about what the disciples learnt and what we can learn from the Bible story, 'Jesus Calms the Storm,' (Mark 4: 35-41) - we had fun with the whole school using body percussion to create the storm until Jesus (Phoebe) said through the microphone, "Quiet. Be still."
